How to Join Girl Scouts

There are several ways that you can participate in the Girl Scouts organization. A girl may choose to be active in more than one pathway. Here are the choices:

1. **Camp**: Experience day or resident camps during summer, winter or spring.
2. **Events**: Participate in events held by Arlington or the Girl Scouts of Eastern Massachusetts that are focused on a particular theme, such as the Girl to Girl Conference, Halloween Hikes or Math Moves U.
3. **Series**: Participate as a group in a series of sessions relating to a specific theme or purpose, such as a six-week video production project or a winter hiking club.
4. **Troop**: Meet regularly during the school year with the same girls and engage in volunteer-led high-quality programs that support learning, relationship building, and fun. Many troops in Arlington are based at our local public and private schools and some are town-wide. We also have one multi-level homeschooling troop. Not every school has a troop at every level. Girl Scout troops are organized by volunteers, most frequently parents of girls.
 - a. **Daisies**: kindergarten-1st grade. We are looking for volunteers to start new kindergarten troops this year.
 - b. **Brownies**: 2nd-3rd grade
 - c. **Juniors**: 4th-5th grade
 - d. **Cadettes**: 6th-8th grade
 - e. **Seniors**: 9th-10th grade
 - f. **Ambassadors**: 11th-12th grade
5. **Travel**: Participate in leadership and cross-cultural opportunities through instate, national, and international travel (for ages 11 and up)
6. **Virtual**: Engage in interactive high-quality program activities in a safe and secure online environment.
